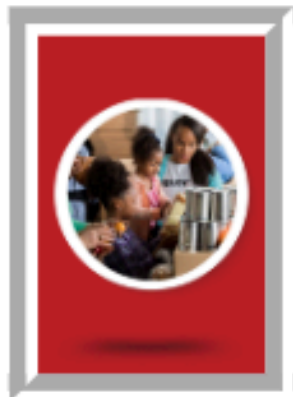

We were proud to support such a great cause – and **BMC took home first place in the race!**

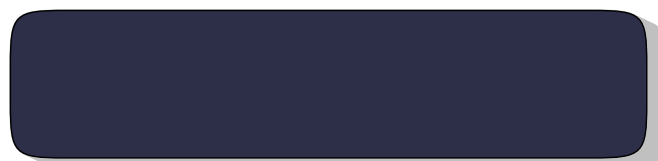


BMC Holiday Giving: Partnering with Helping Up Mission!
